VGCF Spreads Hope with Food Distribution in the Western & Eastern region of Nigeria. On December 20, 2023, the Victorious Grace Charity Foundation (VGCF) held a Christmas food distribution at Umuawuka Mbaoma, Imo State, and at Mowe, Ogun State. The event provided 100 bags of 10kg rice, 25 bags of

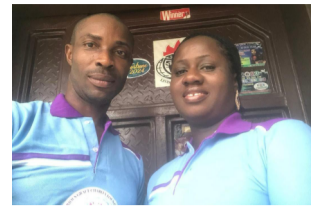

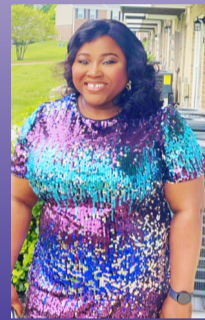

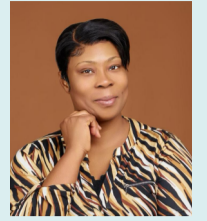

THE RESPONSIBILITY TO CARE: LESSONS FROM THE RICH MAN AND LAZARUS

The parable of the rich man and Lazarus, found in Luke 16:19-31, illustrates our duty to care for those in need. The rich man lived in luxury and ignored Lazarus, a poor beggar at his gate. After death, Lazarus was comforted while the rich man was in torment. The rich man's condemnation came from his indifference to Lazarus' suffering. This teaches us that we are accountable for helping those in need. Jesus' teaching in Matthew 25:31-46 supports this principle. He emphasizes that acts of kindness toward the needy are acts of service

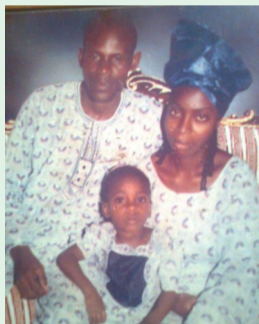
WANT TO BECOME A VGCF VOLUNTEER

Here are the common requirements to Determine Eligibility

- Faith Alignment:** Must be a born again child of God, Spirit filled, set aside for the Lord's use, must be in Agreement with VGCF's Christian values, vision, mission and mandate.
- Age Requirements:** Minimum age is 18yrs though some younger volunteers with parental consent can be allowed.
- Application Process:** Indication of Interest/Submission of an application form by hand, mail or email.
- Interview:** Participation in an interview process to assess suitability and commitment, which can be conducted at the regional levels by the regional leaders.
- References:** Provision of personal or professional references, preferably an existing VGCF Volunteer.
- Digital Viability:** Must be able to connect to the internet to Participate in VGCF Online Activities.
- Commitment:** Willingness to Give and to commit a specified amount of time, finances & other resources which could vary from short-term projects to long-term commitments, especially with attending Victory Upper room Prayer Meetings at least once in a week, Periodic Evangelism, Vigils, Meetings, Retreats & Outreaches.
- Skills and Experience:** Relevant skills or experience related to the volunteer role (e.g., Love & Compassion skills, medical training, teaching, preaching, praying, construction skills etc)

- Physical and Mental Health:** Being in good physical and mental health to handle the demands of the volunteer work.
- Cultural Sensitivity:** Ability to respect and adapt to different cultures and environments.
- Language Skills:** Proficiency in the local language of the area where they will volunteer, if applicable. Financial Responsibility
- Ability to fund their travel,** and living expenses, or participate in fundraising activities if required.
- Teamwork:** Ability to work well in a team, in a cross-cultural and interdenominational environment.
- Flexibility and Adaptability:** Willingness to adapt to changing circumstances and work in potentially challenging environments.

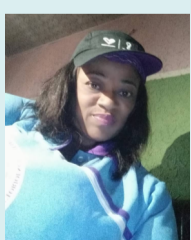
